LARRY - 3:08 PM

Hi how are you?

COACH - 3:08 PM -

Hi Larry. How can I help?

LARRY - 3:08 PM

Basically I want to pray for my family. I am especially worried about my mom

because she has been going through a very rough time.

We need god's guidance to help us through this

COACH - 3:09 PM -

Can you tell me how you have already been praying for her?

LARRY - 3:10 PM

I know only one prayer but I don't know what it's called in english

I pray every day and try follow god's rules always

COACH - 3:11 PM -

If you don't know Jesus as your Savior, thus making you a Christian, you are

not praying to God at all; Just to the sky.

What are God's rules that you always try to follow always?

LARRY - 3:13 PM

Just basic ethics.

I try to be very strict

COACH - 3:13 PM -

I would love to introduce you to Jesus and tell you about His provision for your eternity in heaven instead of hell.

LARRY - 3:14 PM

That would be great

COACH - 3:14 PM -

Among the thousands of facts in the Bible, there are just five, that if you fully

understand and accept as absolute truth, then make the informed decision

to act intelligently upon those facts, you will instantly become a new creature in Christ, be adopted as God's child, receive God's Holy Spirit, and possess eternal life, having had the full penalty for all your sin paid once and for all by Jesus! Are you truly interested in these facts?

LARRY - 3:15 PM
Yes definitely

COACH - 3:15 PM -
I will share these five facts, one at a time, each including the Bible verse from which it comes. The first three are bad news, but the last two are good news. After each fact, I'll give you an opportunity to either ask for clarification or tell me that you understand and accept that fact as absolute truth. OK?

LARRY - 3:15 PM
Yes

COACH - 3:16 PM -

Fact #1 - You are a sinner by nature and by act. (Rom. 3:23) For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; --- Clarification or acceptance as absolute truth?

LARRY - 3:16 PM
Uh sorry what was I supposed to reply again?
I accept this as a fact
I am a sinner

COACH - 3:17 PM -
Fact #2 - Your sin has separated you from God. (Isa. 59:2) But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.; --- Clarification or acceptance as absolute truth?

LARRY - 3:17 PM
clarification

What do I have to do to be a good christian?

COACH - 3:19 PM -

You said you know you are a sinner. Well that sin is totally incompatible with God's holiness and separates you from Him.

LARRY - 3:19 PM

Yes that makes sense

COACH - 3:20 PM -

Do you accept this separation as absolute truth?

LARRY - 3:20 PM

I accept it as absolute truth

COACH - 3:20 PM -

Fact #3 - The penalty for your sin is death. (Rom. 6:23a); For the wages of sin is death; --- (Death = eternal separation from God, both physically and spiritually in HELL) --- Clarification or acceptance as absolute truth?

LARRY - 3:20 PM

accept

COACH - 3:21 PM -

Because these facts are true, where will you spend eternity if you died right now?

LARRY - 3:21 PM

I'm afraid I might go to hell. I made a lot of mistakes in the past But I try to be a good person

COACH - 3:22 PM -

Hell is the correct answer, Larry. Now, would like the good news I promised earlier?

LARRY - 3:22 PM

Yes

COACH - 3:23 PM -

Fact #4 - God, Himself, has provided the payment for your sin and offered you eternal life instead. (Rom. 6:23b); but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. --- Clarification or acceptance as absolute truth?

LARRY - 3:24 PM

I don't fully understand. So I can live forever but I still need to go to hell if I make mistakes?

COACH - 3:25 PM -

Not necessarily because God Himself has made a way for you to be reconciled with Him. But you need to accept it.

LARRY - 3:25 PM

I accept it as truth.

COACH - 3:25 PM -

Fact #5 - To be released from the penalty of all your sin, you must believe that Jesus, God Himself, has already paid your penalty in full on the cross where He died a bloody death for all of your sins, past, present, and even future. Jesus's blood is the only payment that God will accept for your total sin debt. (Acts 16:31) Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved
Clarification or acceptance as absolute truth?

LARRY - 3:26 PM

Yes I accept it as truth

COACH - 3:26 PM -

Now that you have accepted all five facts as absolute truth, be very careful here! Accepting these five facts as absolute truth isn't the same as making the informed decision to place your trust in Christ's blood, shed on your behalf as full payment for your sin debt. Based upon these five facts, have you decided where you will place your full trust for God's forgiveness and His gift of eternal life, including the forsaking of all other gods you may have been trusting? If so, please tell me in one full sentence what decision you have made.

LARRY - 3:28 PM

I accept that Jesus died for our sins and I trust that God will forgive me if I honour this.

COACH - 3:30 PM -

You are a sinner. God can't forgive your sin penalty for sins past, present, and even future. Until you realize that Jesus shed His blood for YOUR sins, and ask Jesus to apply His blood to you personal sin debt. Does that make sense, Larry?

LARRY - 3:31 PM

Yes that makes sense

COACH - 3:32 PM -

That is a decision you must make on your own, Larry. Does that make sense?

COACH - 3:33 PM -

Then tell me when you have asked Jesus to be your Savior and cover ALL your sins, past, present, and even future, Larry.

LARRY - 3:35 PM

I'm not sure if I've done that yet are there any prayers for this?

COACH - 3:35 PM -

No special words. Prayer is just your heart talking to Jesus. Can you do that so I can see and know that Jesus is now your Savior,

LARRY?

LARRY - 3:37 PM

Yes I ask Jesus to be my savior and and cover my sins.

COACH - 3:38 PM -

Fantastic! Only you and God know this for sure. However, the moment you placed your trust in Christ's shed blood as full payment for your sin debt, you

were born again as God's child and His Holy Spirit immediately took up

residence in your life, even closer to you than your own skin. You know, an appropriate first prayer as God's newborn child, would be to thank Him for loving you and allowing His Son, Jesus, to pay the full penalty for your sin by

becoming your Savior. What do you think about doing that?
